CHLORINATED GENERAL PURPOSE DETERGENT /SANITISER

CHLORDET is a chlorinated general purpose alkaline detergent powder formulated as a cleaner/sanitiser for the food industry. It is non-corrosive at use dilution on stainless steel and plastic surfaces. Care should be exercised on alloy, brass, copper and aluminium surfaces to ensure concentrations are correct and that contact times are minimised.

CHLORDET is formulated with a balanced mix of alkalis, available chlorine, sequestering agents, and specialised surfactants. **CHLORDET** offers reliable removal of organic soils such as proteins, fats, oils, and biofilms. Its medium foaming nature provides excellent surface coverage during manual and mechanical cleaning applications. It combines effective cleaning action with broad spectrum sanitising properties making it ideal for hygiene-critical environments.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

CHLORDET is readily soluble in hot or cold water, but should not be used at temperatures above 70°C.

Test surface for compatibility.

CHLORINE YIELD:

1:50 solution - 500 ppm chlorine

1:100 solution - 250 ppm chlorine

USE RATE

- 10 gm/litre (100 to 1) Standard Soils
- 20 gm/litre (50 to 1) Heavy Soils

Water temperature preferably hot to 70°C. Apply with cloth, mop, or brush. Leave for 5 – 10 minutes. Rinse product contacting surfaces with potable water after use.
